If a scholarship is awarded, parent(s)/student will be **required** to donate their time at a rate of \$10 per hour equal to amount of the scholarship performing duties such as filing, rehearsal set up/strike, cleaning, or other similar tasks. The student will be required to write weekly for the NFT blog during the rehearsal and performance period. Students are eligible for a scholarship once per year.
